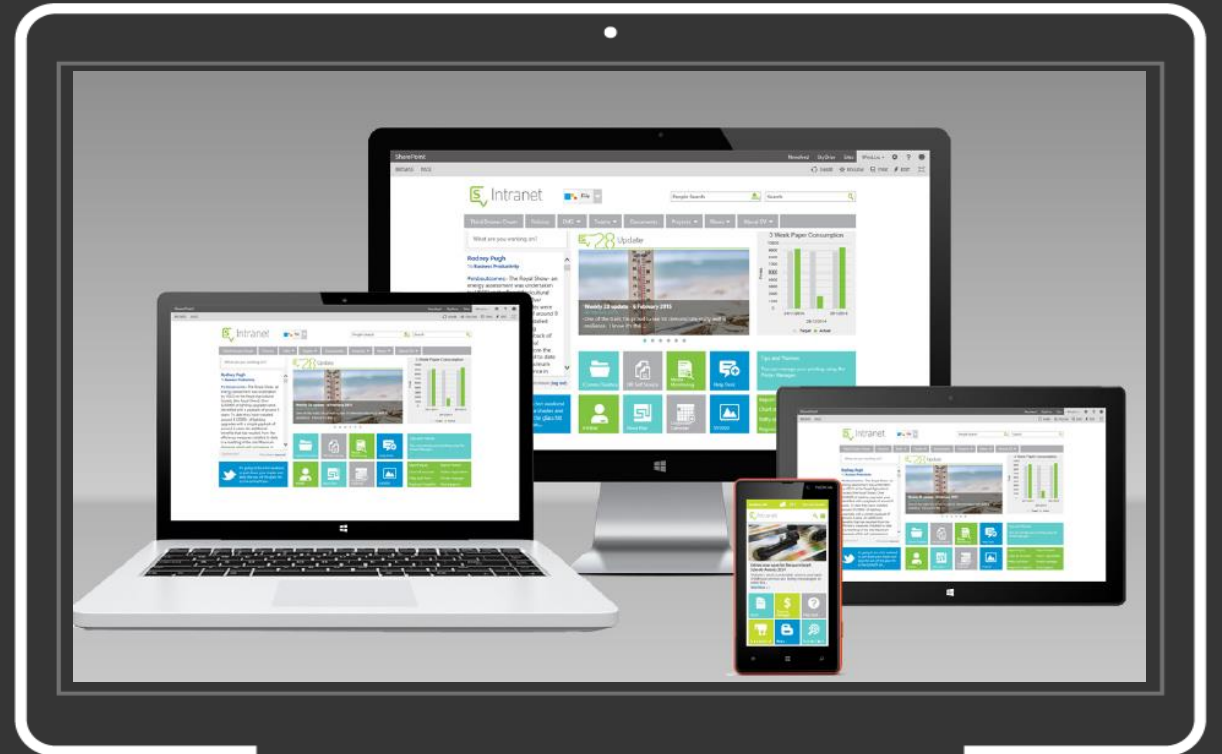
Static, link driven & sole responsibility of one team member

Unable to share project updates, insights or successes

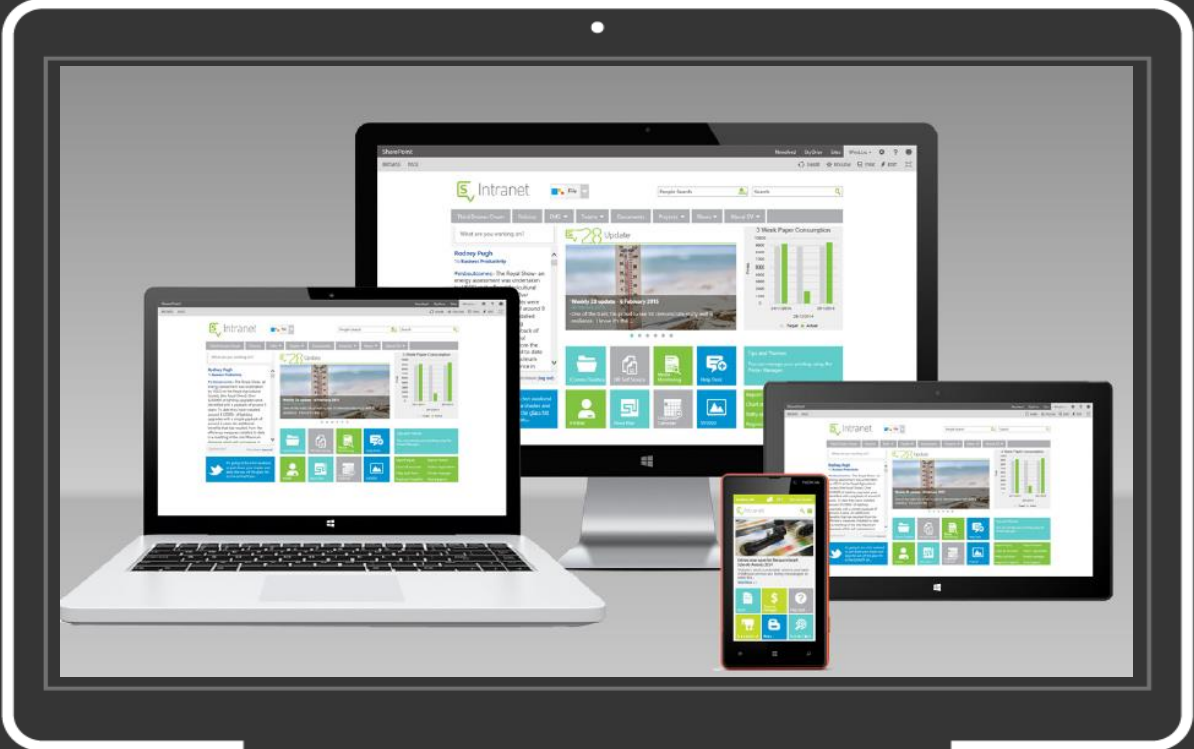
## Benefits




